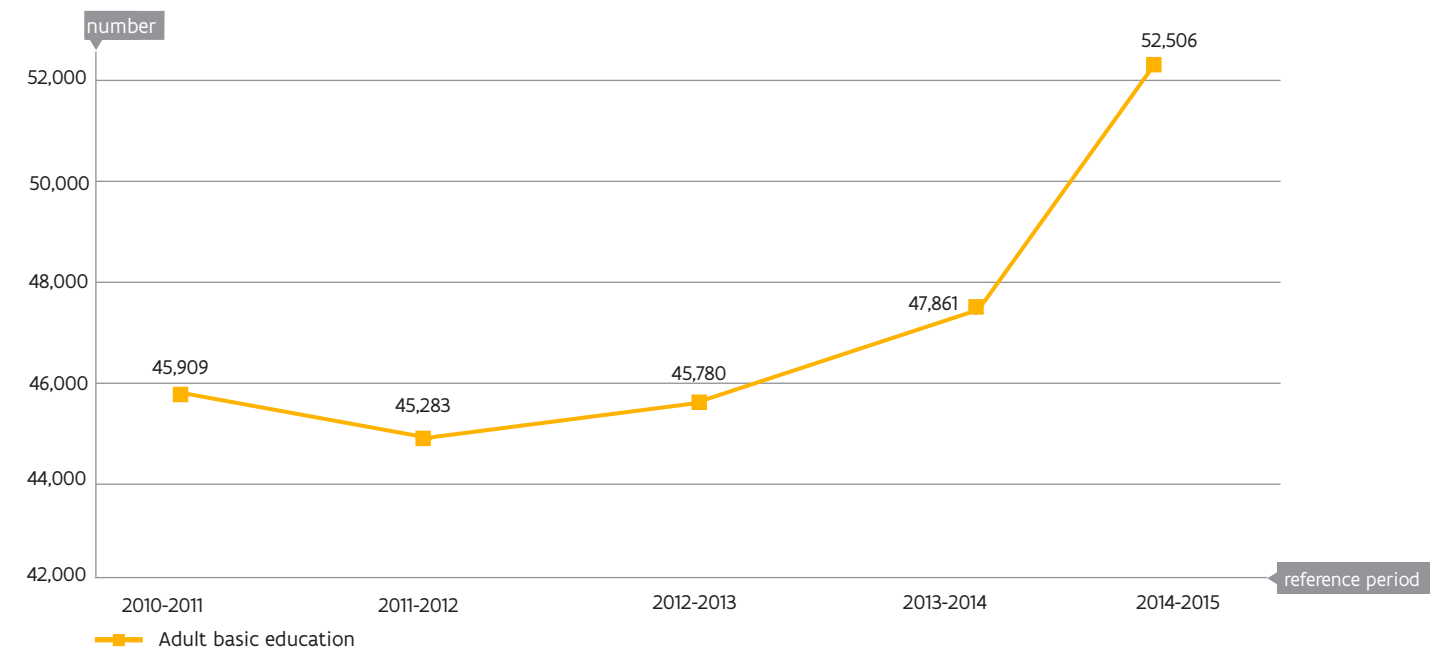
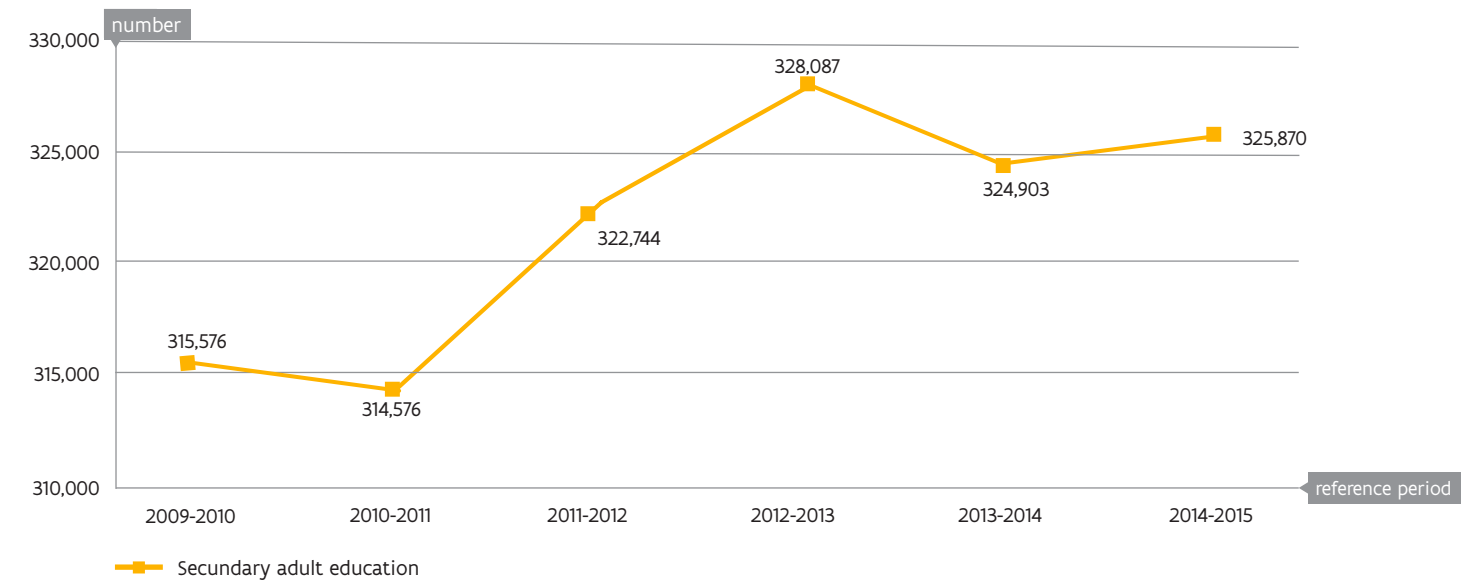

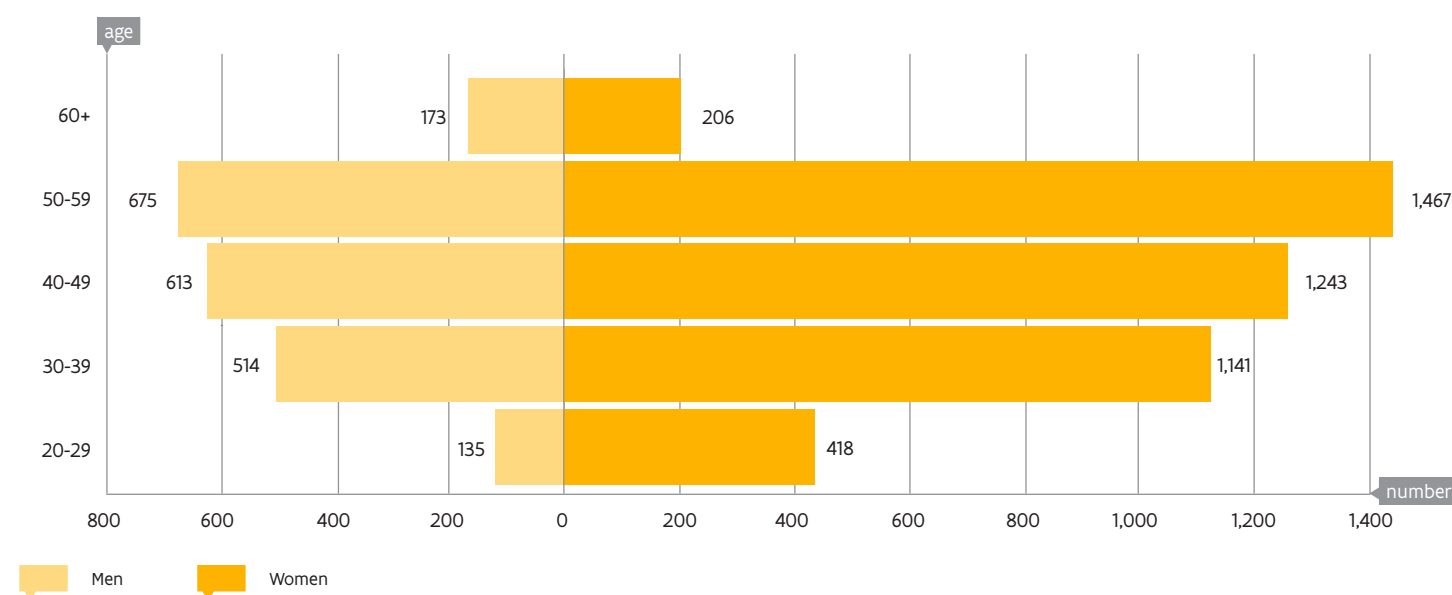

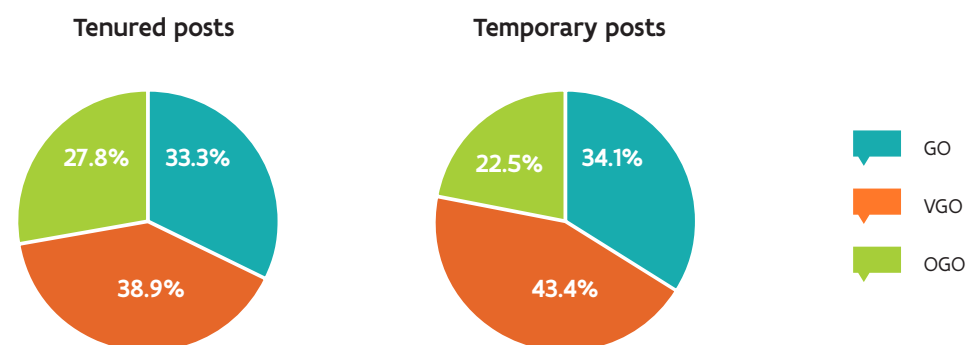
2 Staff in secondary adult education by age group and gender

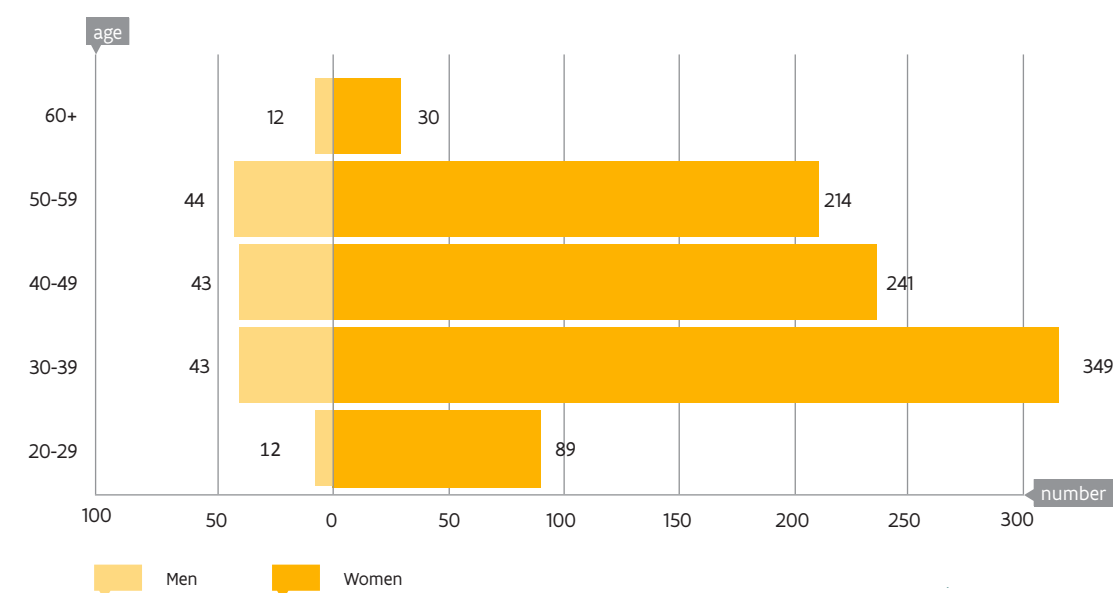
