



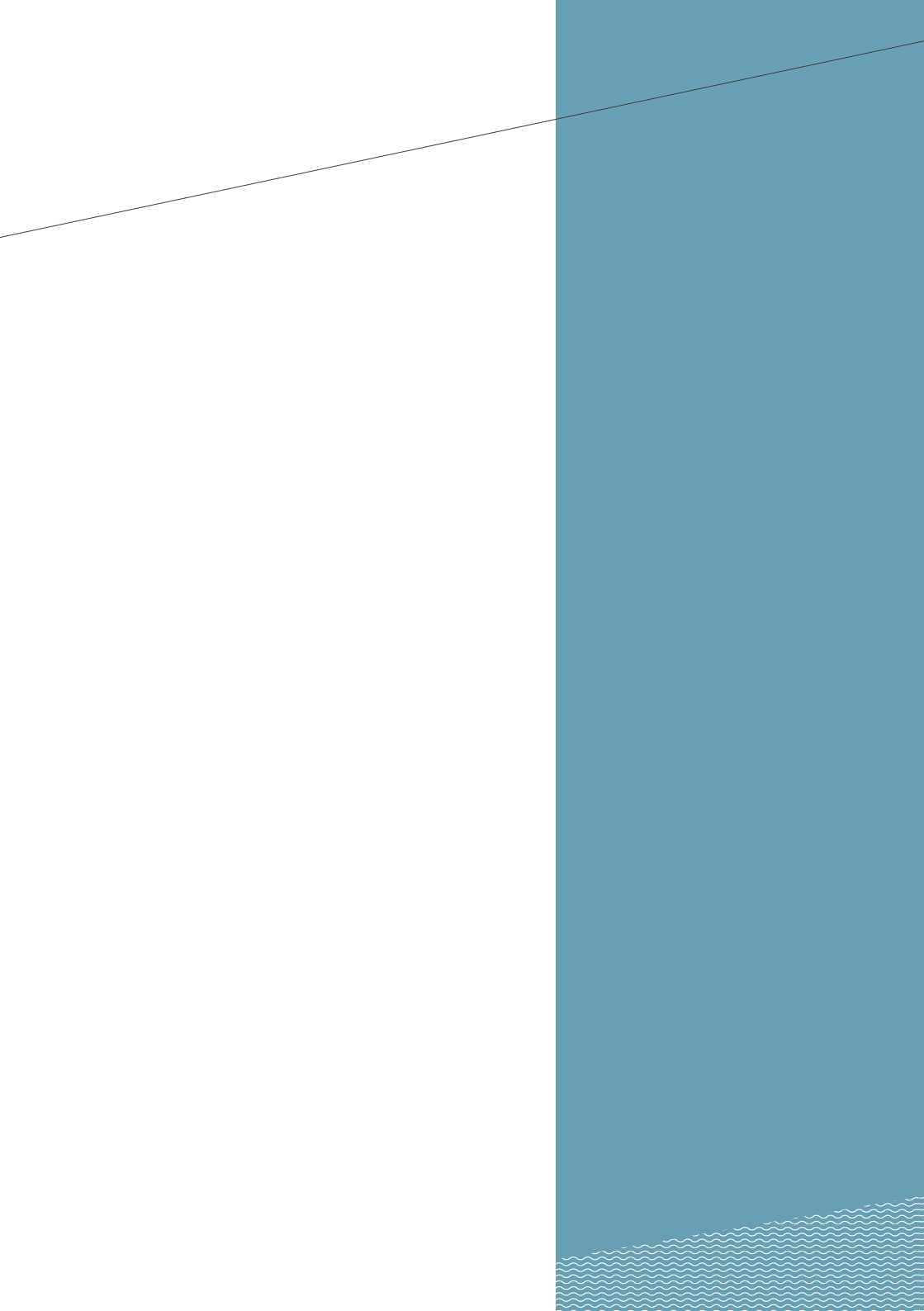

## INTRODUCTION

The brochure **Flanders in Figures** gives a concise picture of Flanders based on a comprehensive set of Flemish official statistics. The statistics cover a wide range of themes and are grouped into four main sections: population and society, economy and enterprises, environment and government and governance. Several themes included a brief comparison of Flemish data with the situation in other regions of the European Union.

The statistics in this brochure always refer to the **Flemish Region**, except where it is indicated that they concern the **Flemish Community**. The Flemish Region is responsible for matters relating to the territory, the so-called 'place-specific' matters (e.g. economy). Matters relating directly to the inhabitants, the so-called 'person-related' matters (e.g. culture), fall within the responsibility of the Flemish Community.

# About the Statistics Flanders network

**Statistics Flanders (SF)** is the network of Flemish administration entities that develop, produce and publish official statistics. These official statistics provide a reliable and high-quality picture of Flanders: from the people who live and work there, to the economy and the living environment, to the position of Flanders in the world. At the same time, the Statistics Flanders network offers a broader context by thematically compiling statistics, mapping trends and placing figures in a geographical perspective.

The Statistics Flanders network pursues a coordinated statistics policy, so that the official statistics about Flanders and the underlying data are readily available to all via one central portal at <https://www.vlaanderen.be/en/statistics-flanders>. In this way, policymakers, researchers, organisations, companies and citizens are provided with fast, reliable, correct and independent information about Flanders.

We develop, produce and disseminate all official statistics about Flanders in accordance with the legal provisions and international principles of quality, relevance and professional independence. These principles are also reflected in the four strategic objectives that guide the work of the Statistics Flanders network:

- Official statistics are for everyone.
- We provide high-quality statistics using a methodical approach.
- We are transparent and work independently.
- We work innovatively and focus on the future.

The Flanders Statistics Authority (VSA), headed by the chief statistician of the Flemish administration, coordinates and supports the Statistics Flanders network so that the development, production and dissemination of official statistics by the network is done in a qualitative and systematic way.

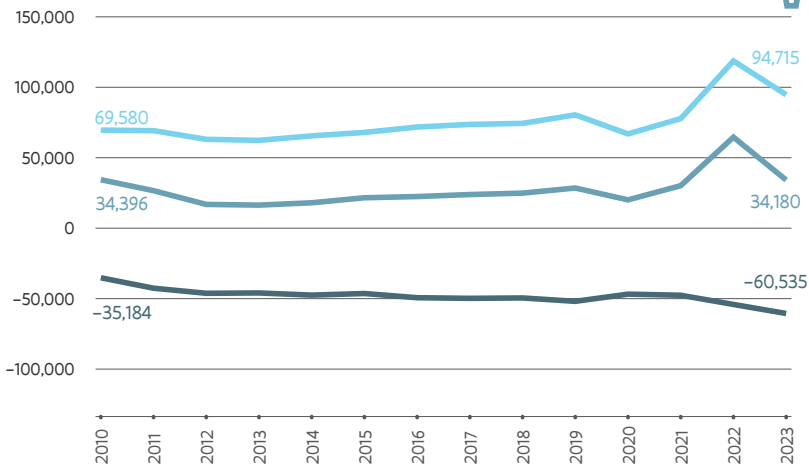

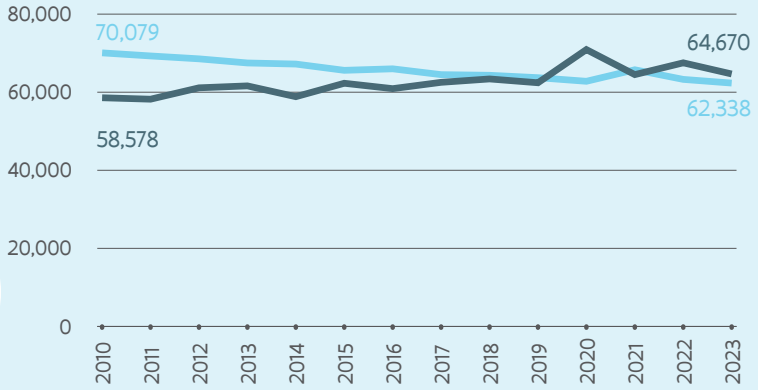

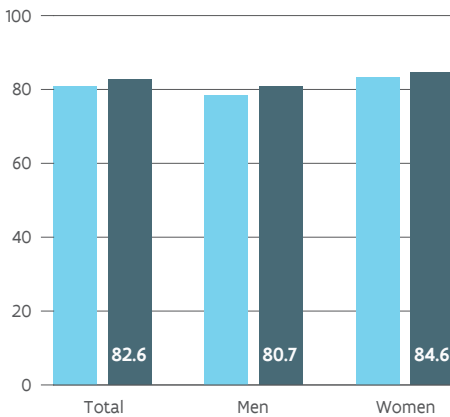

(expected years of life)

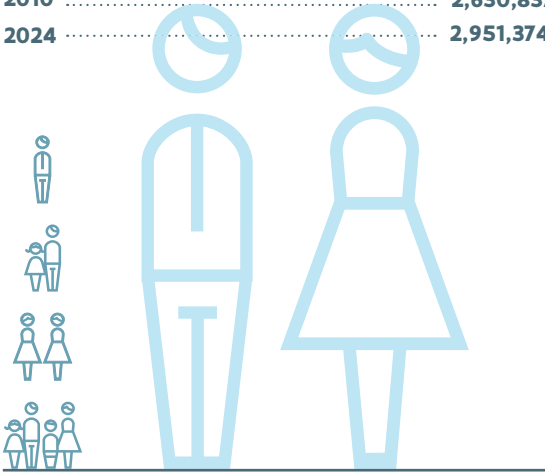

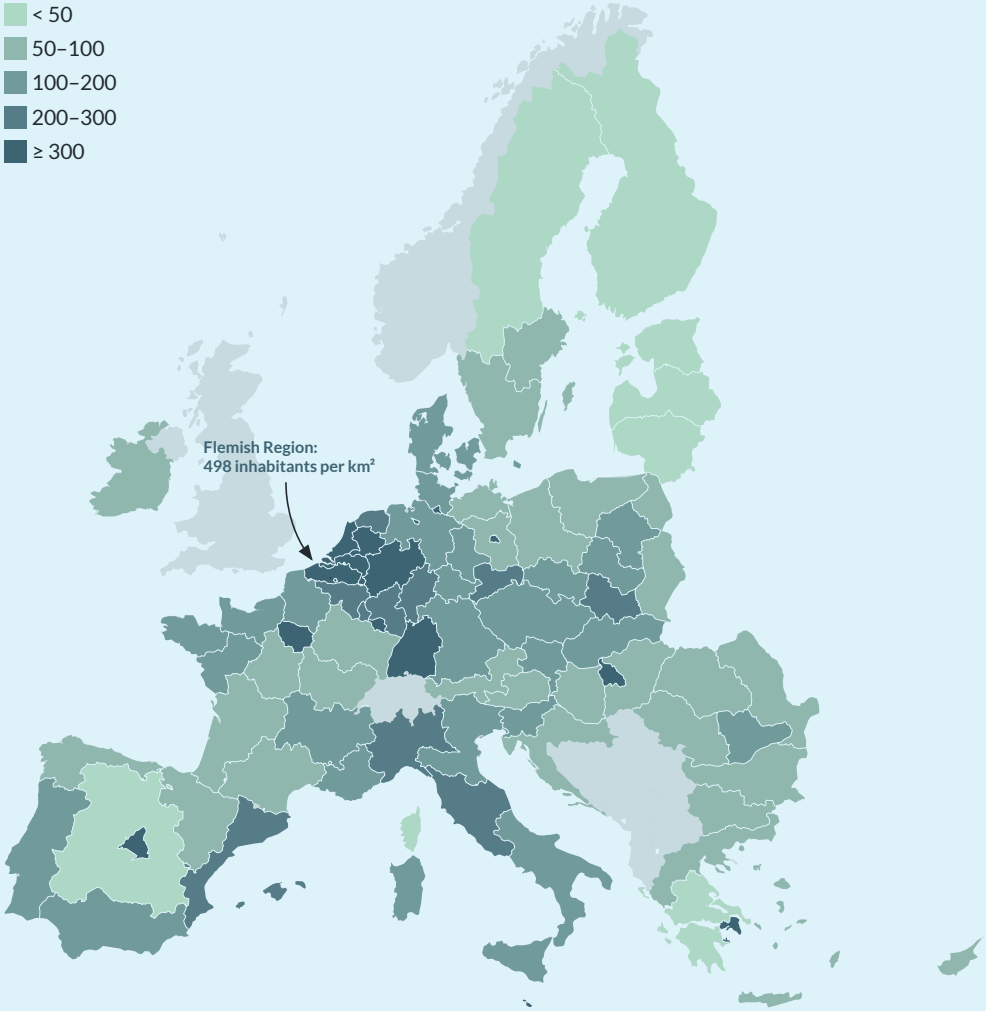

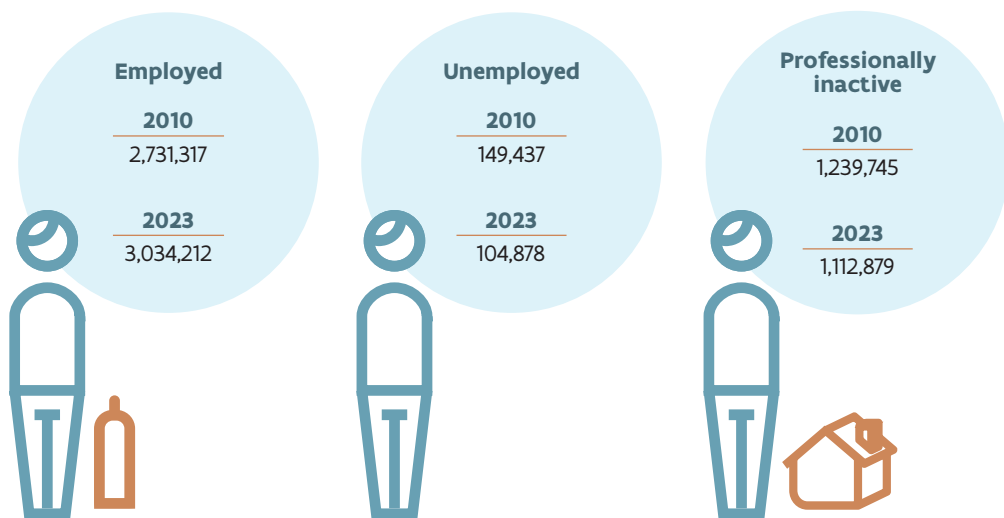

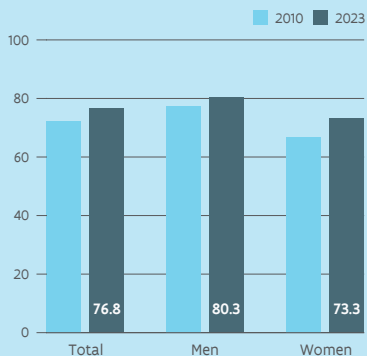

## Population (aged 15-64) by socio-economic position

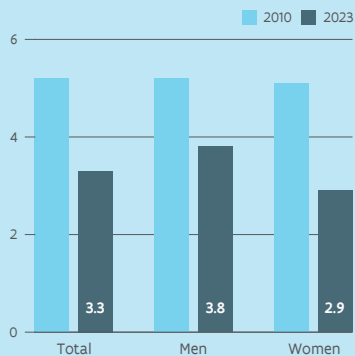

## Employment rate (aged 20-64) (%)

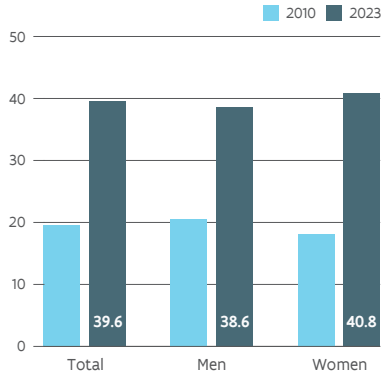


## ILO unemployment rate (aged 15-64) (%)

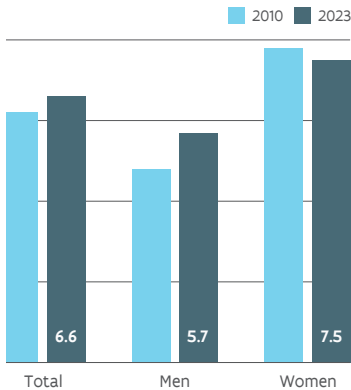




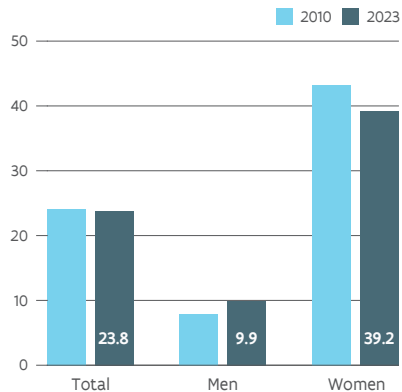
## Employees working from home (aged 20-64) (%)

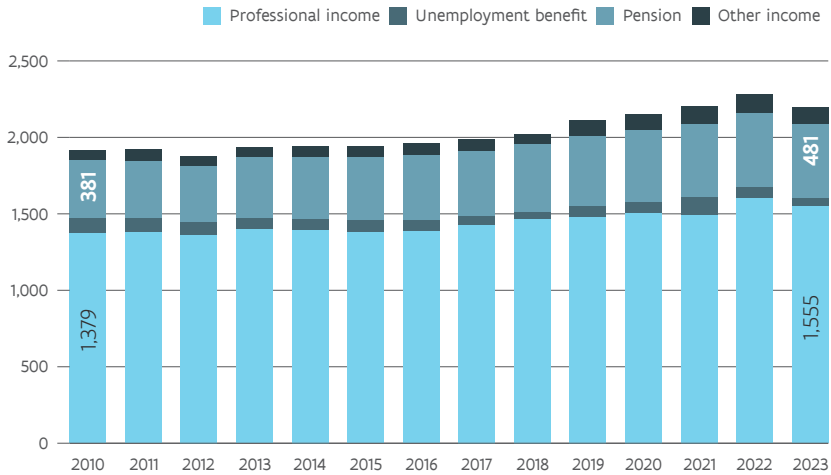

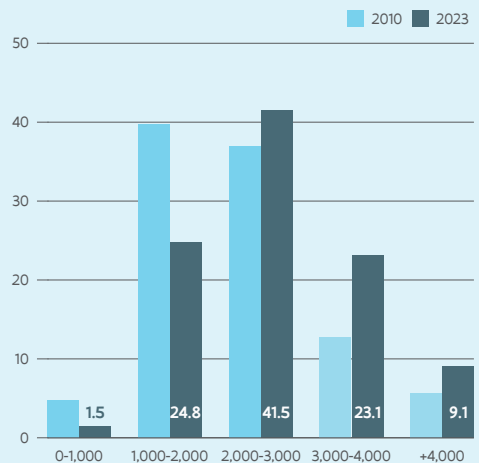
## Personal income per month of the population (aged 18 and over)

(euro, real prices of 2022)

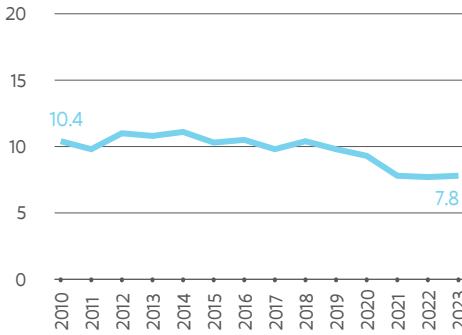


## Breakdown of population by net equivalent household income

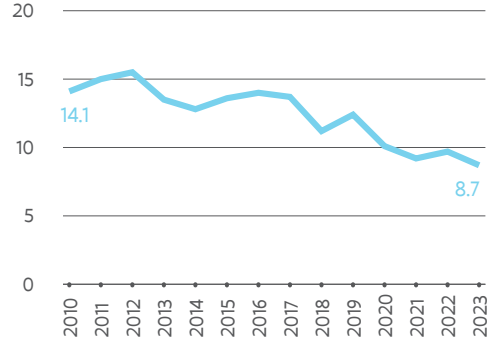

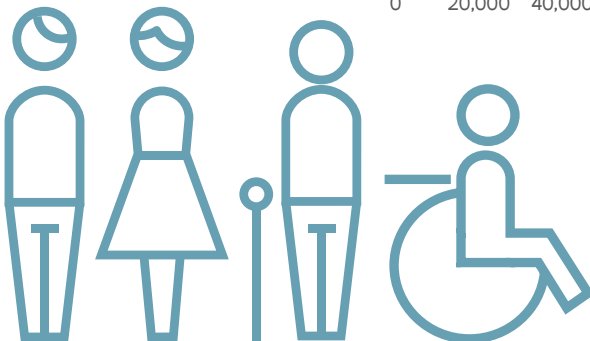
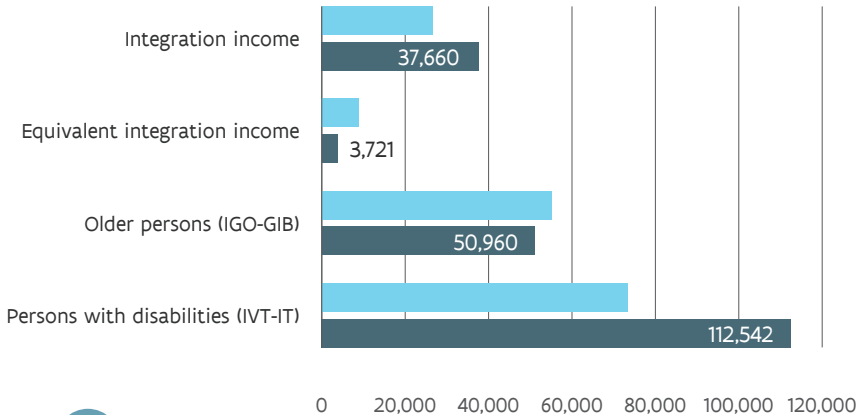
## Population living in households making ends meet with difficulty (%)

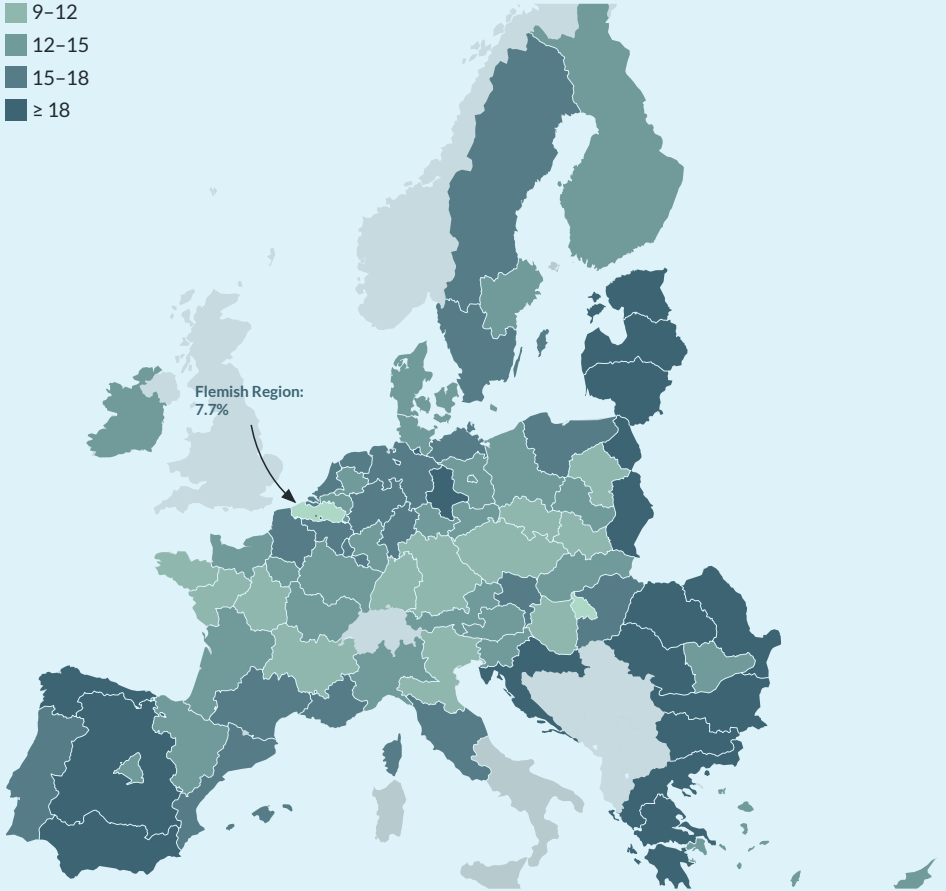

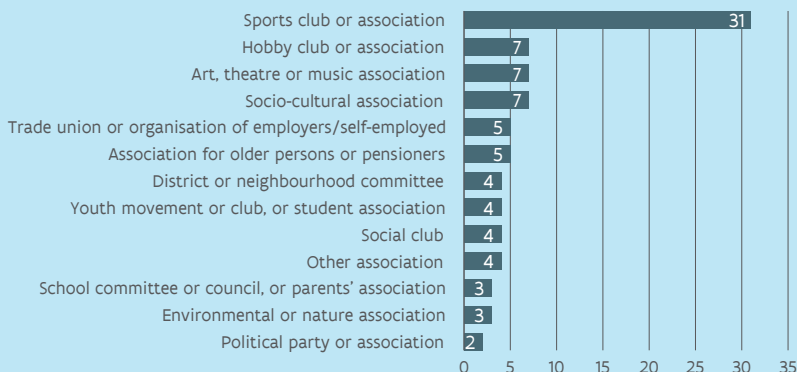

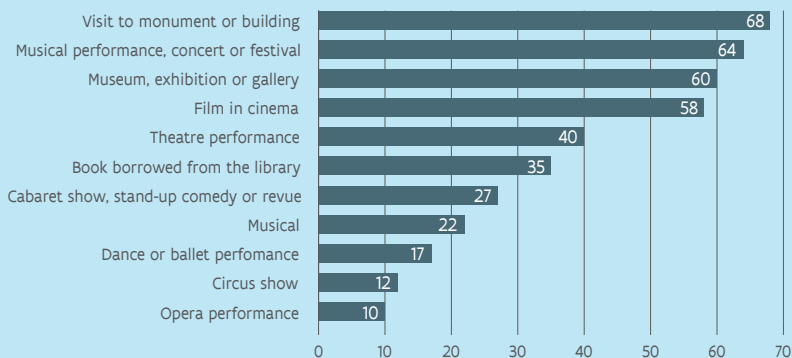
## Population (aged 18 and over) with at least weekly social contact in 2023 (%)



## Active membership of associations (aged 18 and over) in 2023 (%)



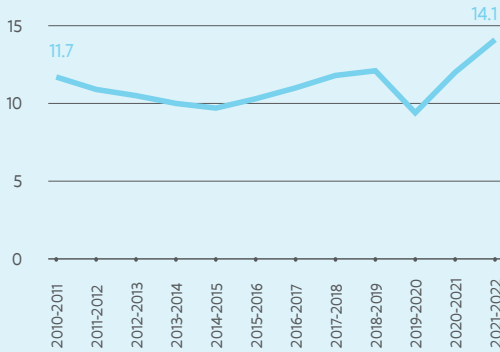
## Cultural participation (aged 18 and over) in 2023 (% at least once a year)

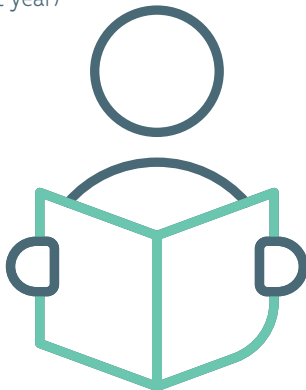
## Early leavers from education and training\* (%)



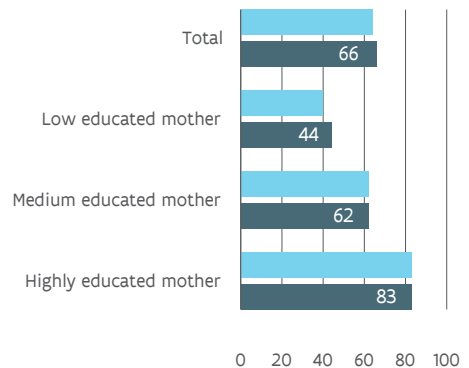

(% leaving secondary education and moving on to higher education the following year, by exit year)

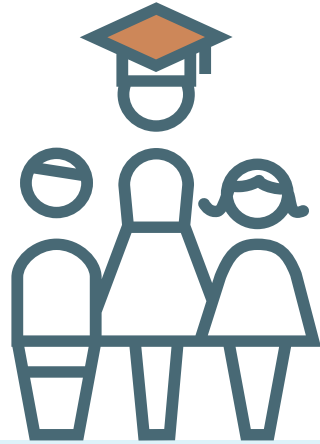

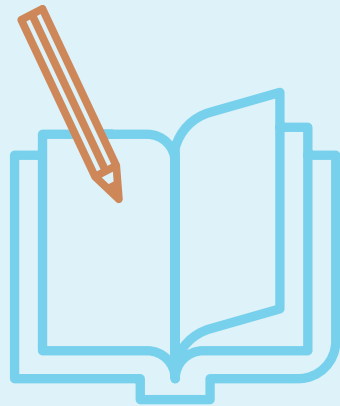
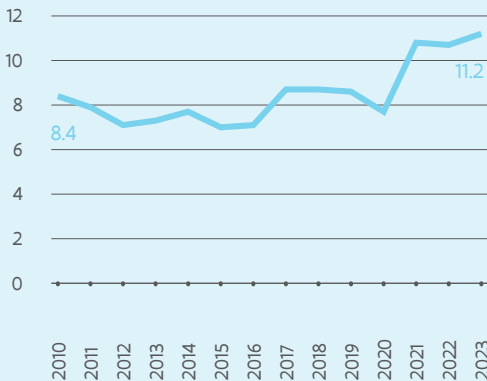
## Share of 25-34 year-olds with higher education qualifications (%)

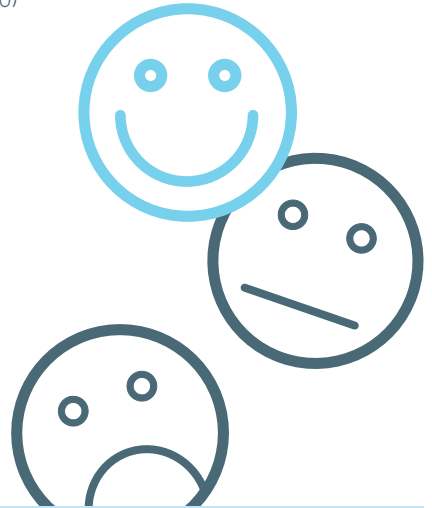
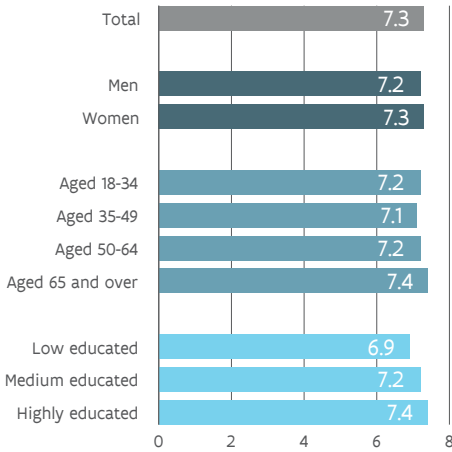
## Participation rate in education and training (aged 25-64) over past 4 weeks (%)



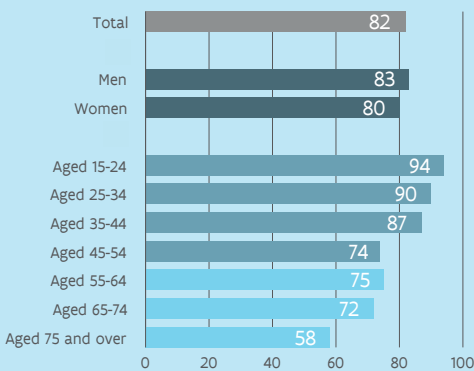

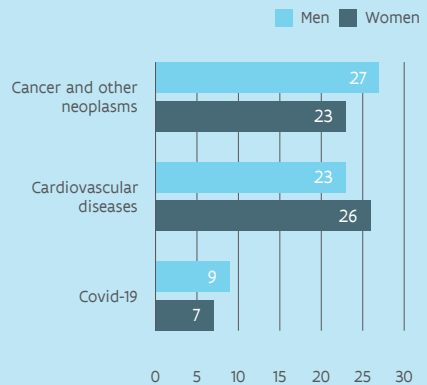
## Overall life satisfaction of population (aged 18 and over) in 2023 (score out of 10)



## Population (aged 15 and over) in good health in 2018 (%)



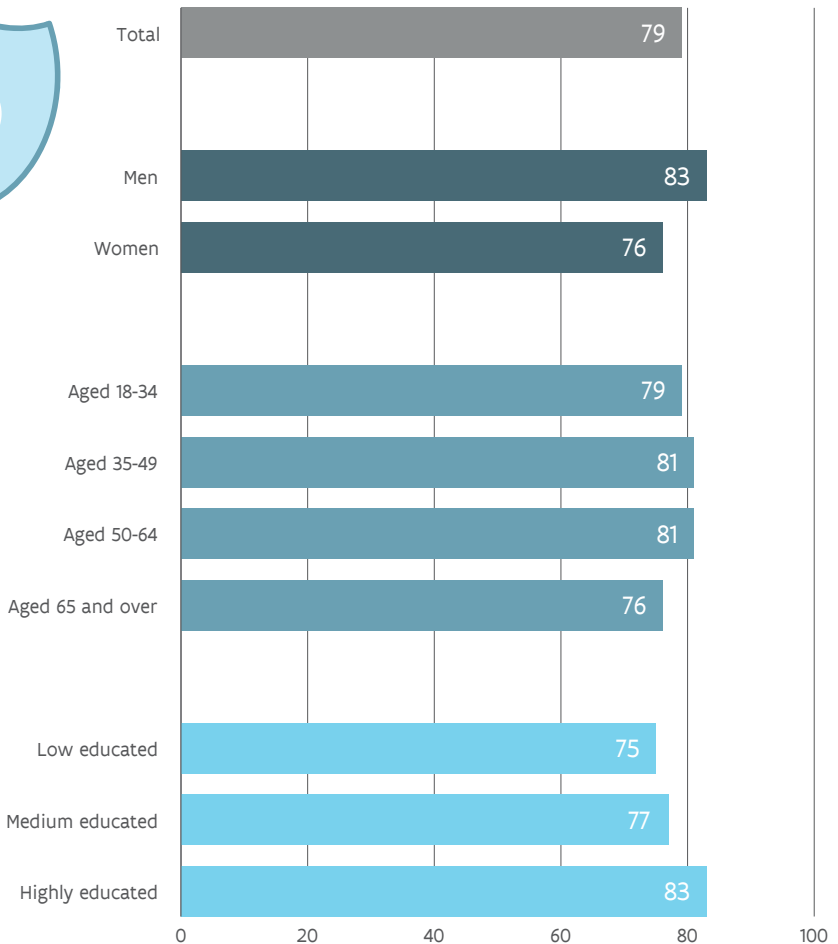
## Leading causes of death in 2021 (%)

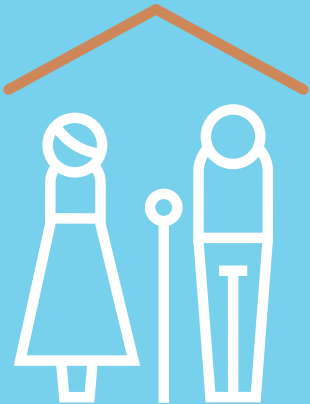

## Perceptions of personal safety in the neighbourhood of population (aged 18 and over) in 2023 (% seldom or never unsafe)

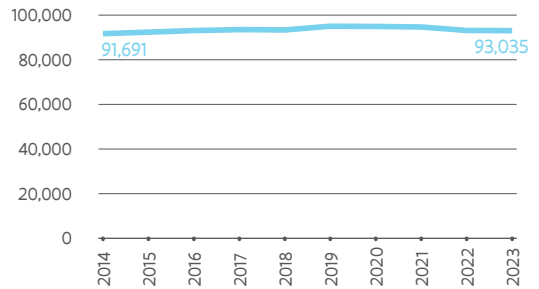

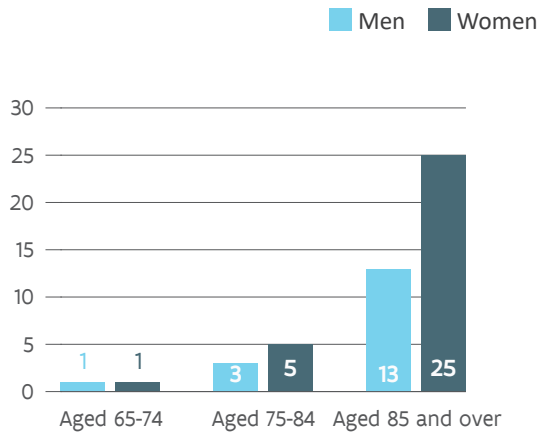


## Formal childcare places for babies and toddlers\* (number)

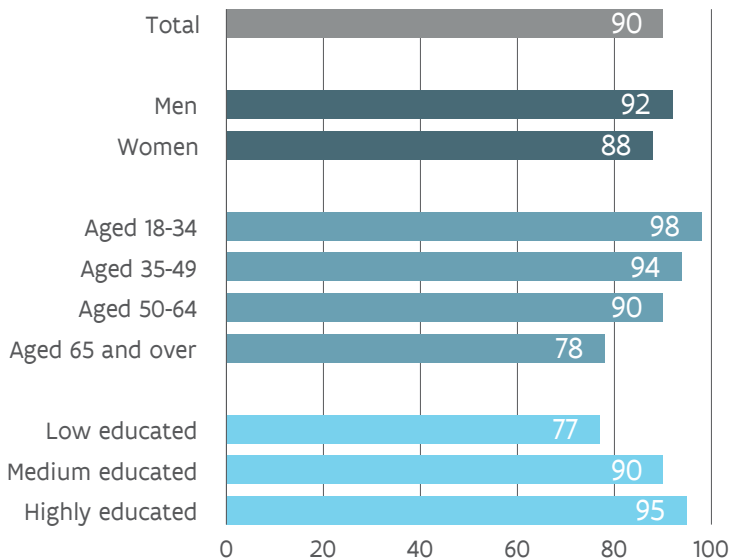
## Population in residential care centres in 2021 (%)

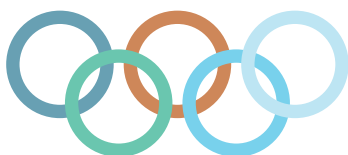

## Population (aged 18 and over) practising sports at least annually in 2023 (%)

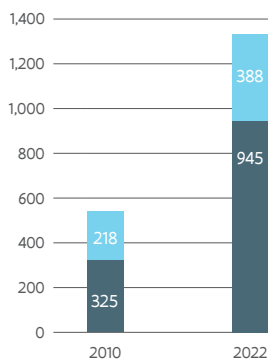




## Olympic top sports index

(index points gained by individuals and teams)

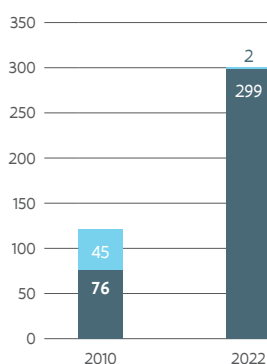

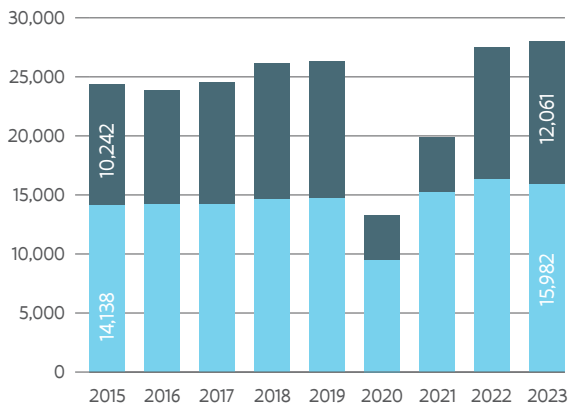


## Overnight stays by tourists

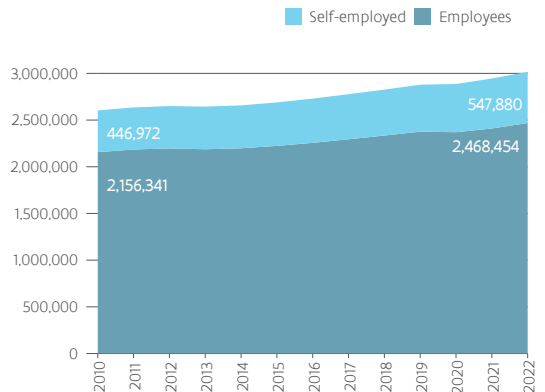
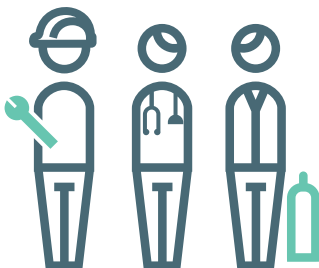
## GDP per capita (euro PPS)



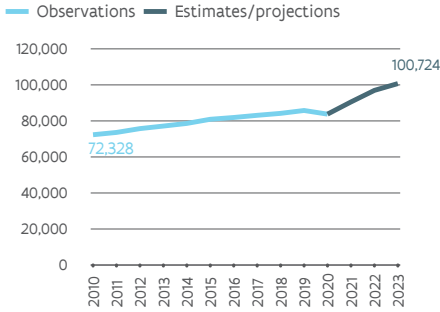
## Real economic growth (%)



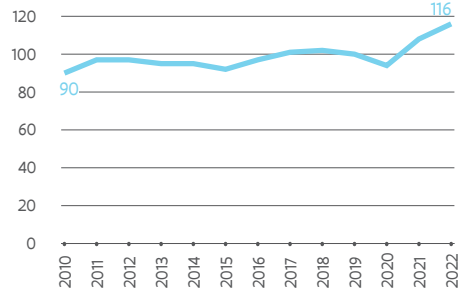

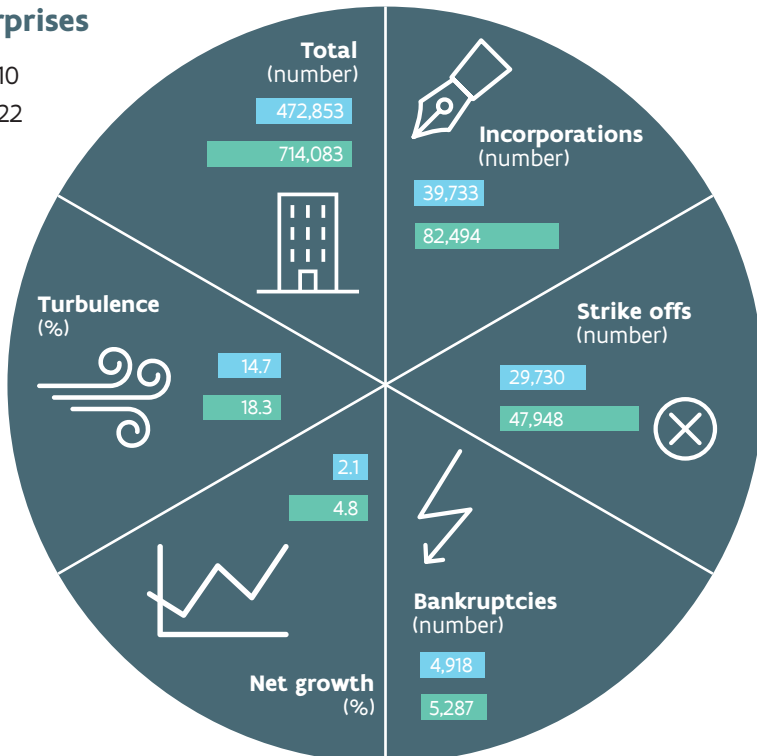


## Export ratio\* (% GDP)

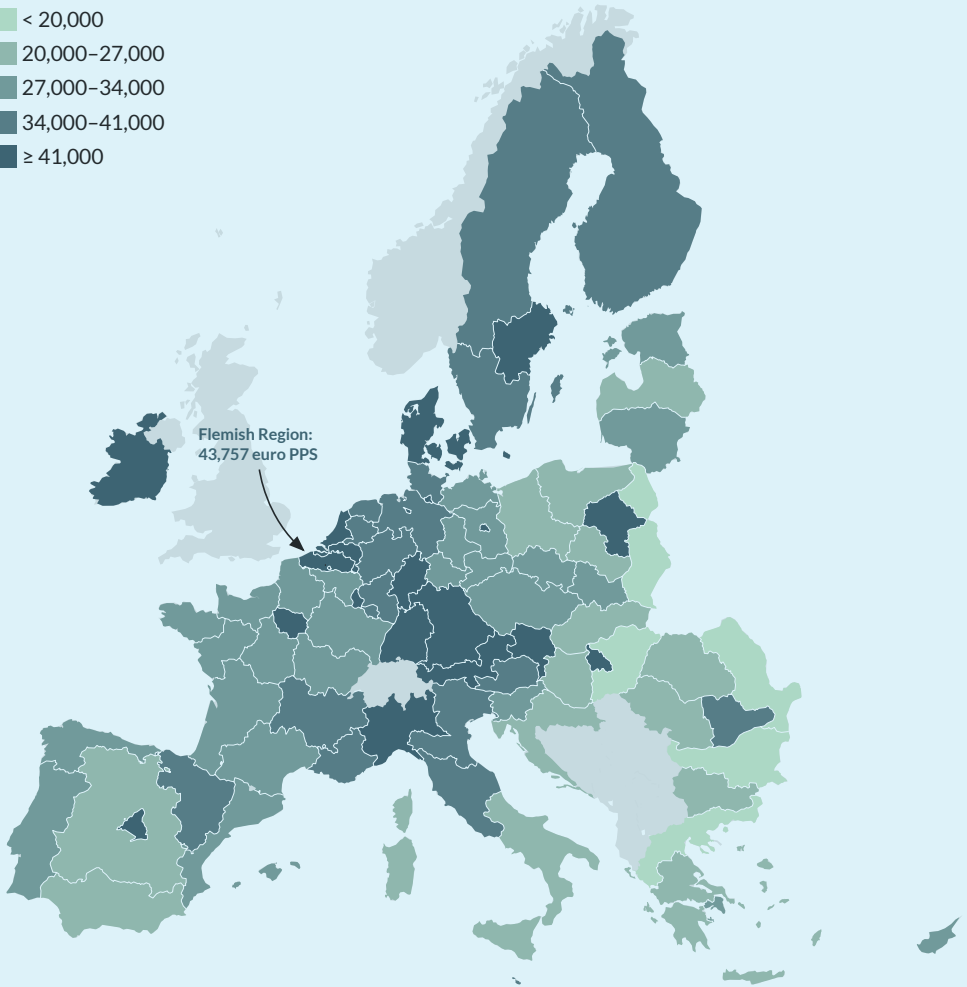

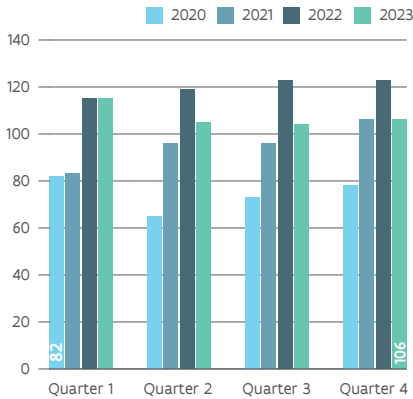

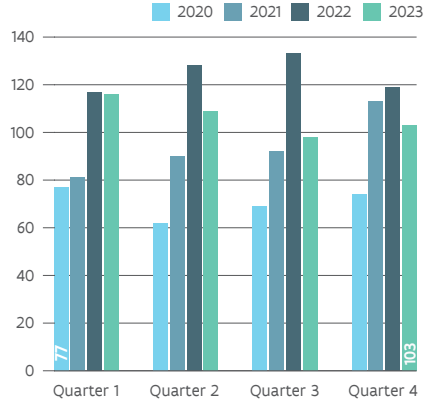
## Goods exports\*

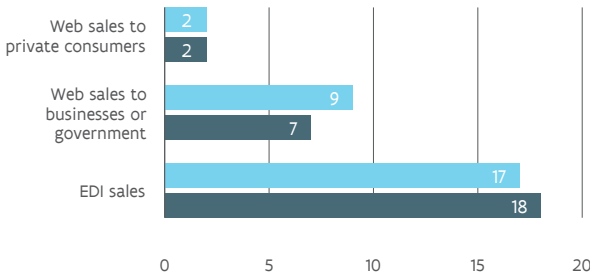

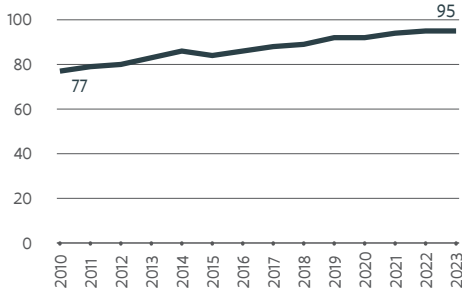
## Turnover from e-commerce by type

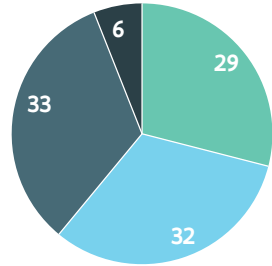


## Households with internet connection (% households)

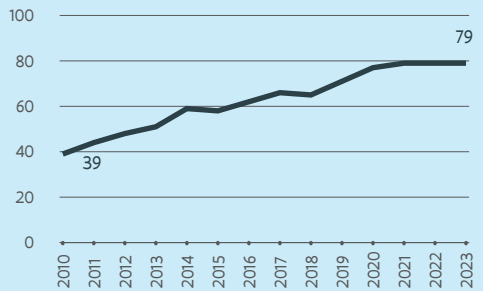


## Digital skills in 2023 (% of population aged 16-74)

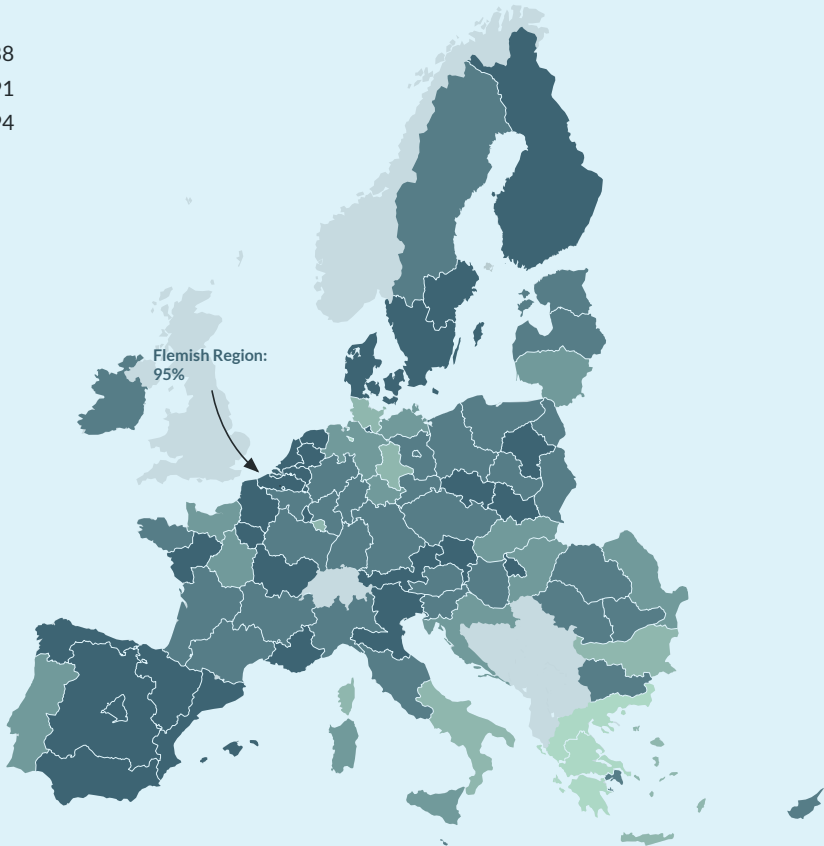
## Online purchases for private use in the past year (% of population aged 16-74)

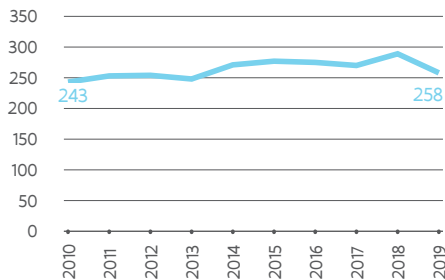

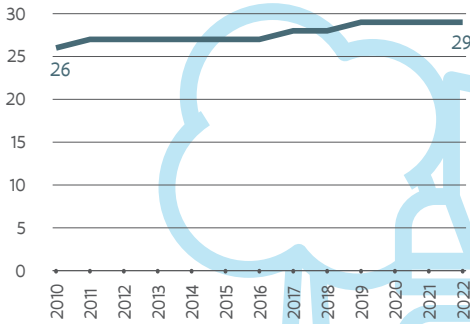

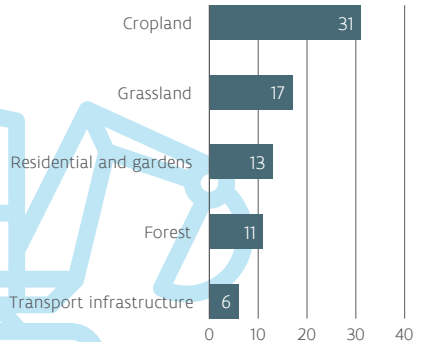

## Top 5 land use in 2022 (%)

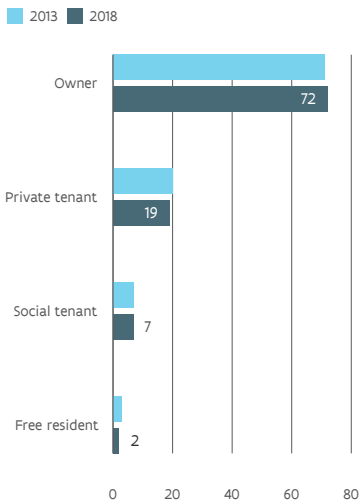

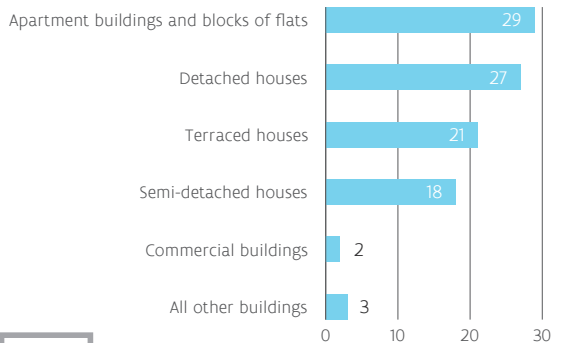

(% households)



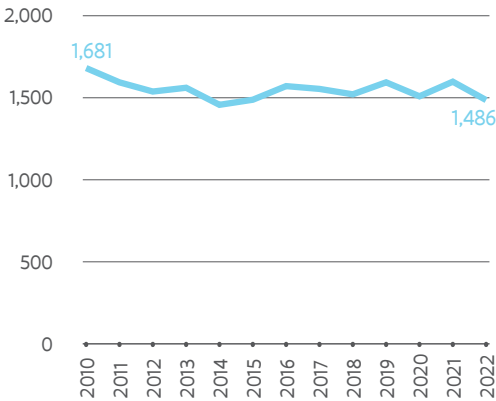

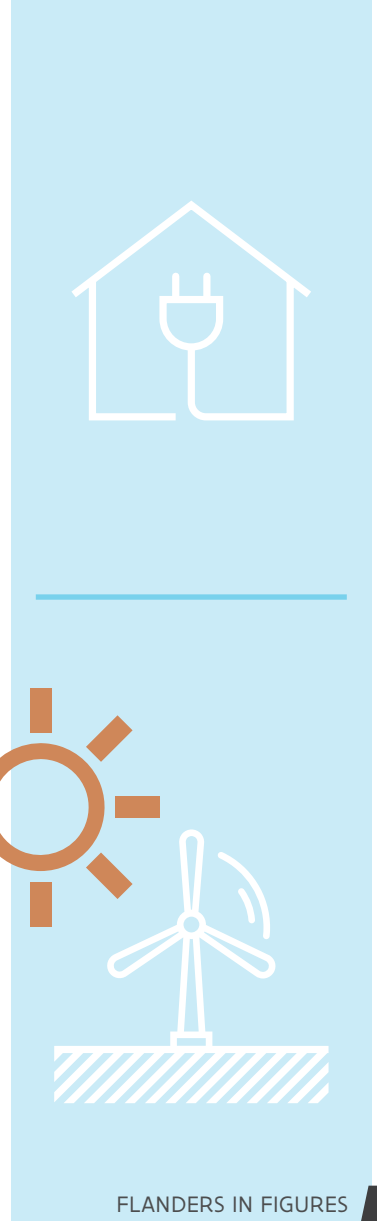
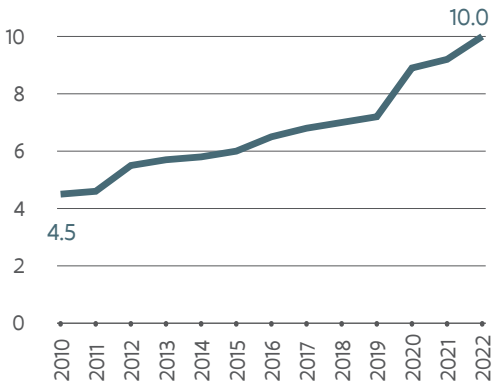

### Gross domestic energy consumption (petajoules)



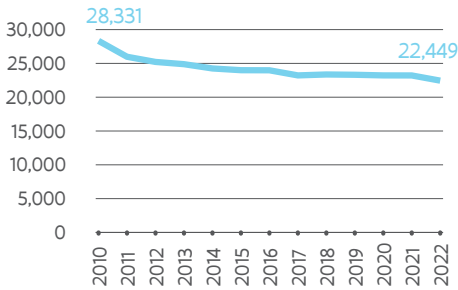
### Renewable energy in gross final energy consumption (%)



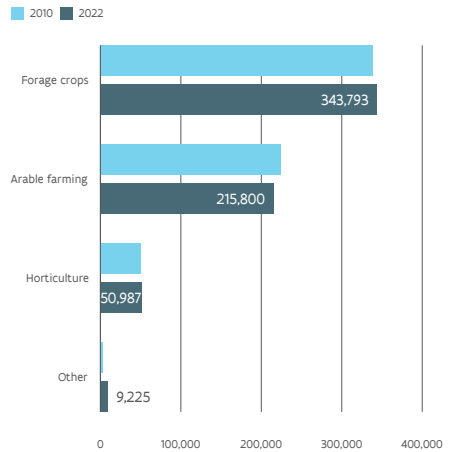

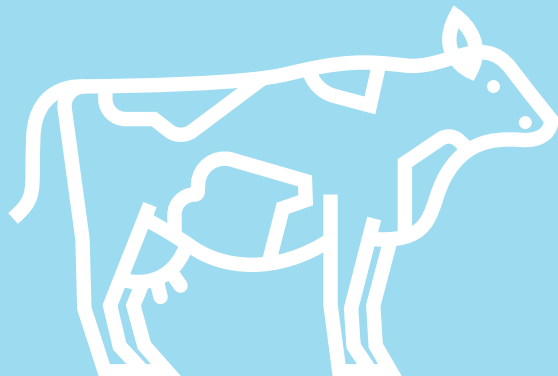

(EU-NUTS 1 regions, units of cattle per hectare)

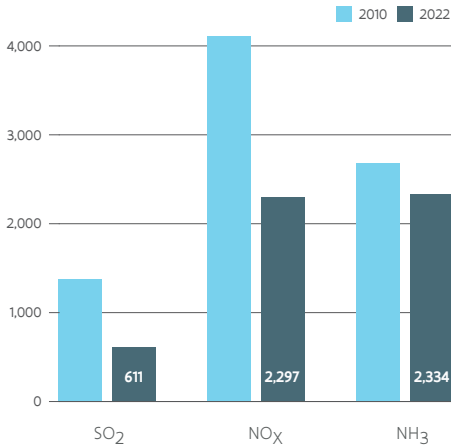

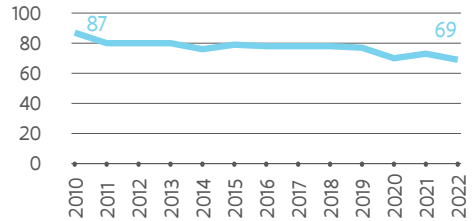
## Potentially acidifying emissions

(million acid equivalents)



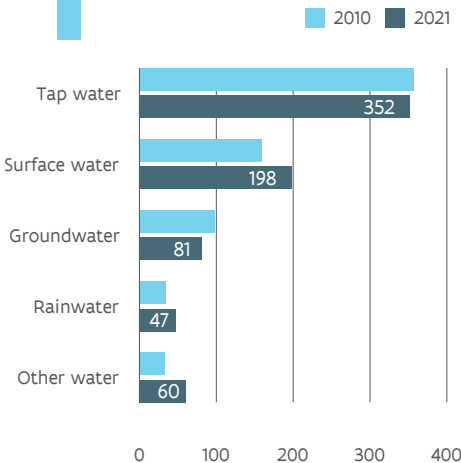
## Greenhouse gas emissions

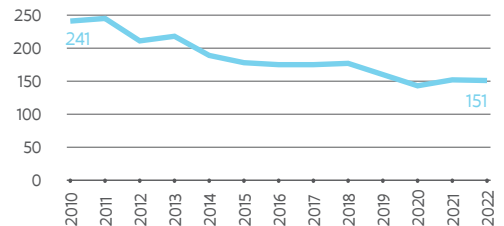
## Water consumption

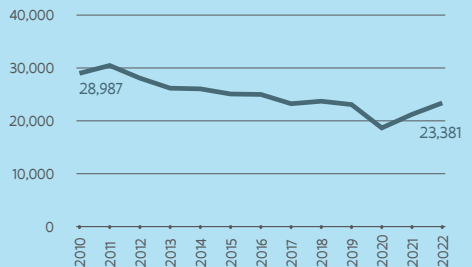

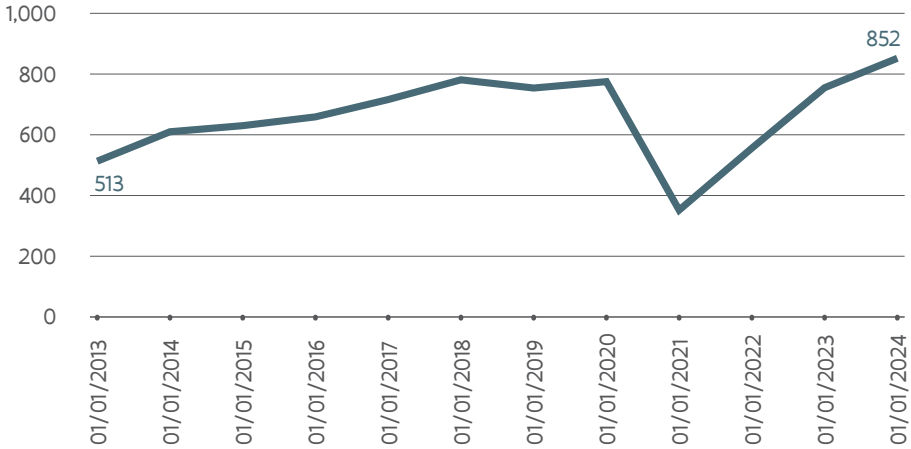

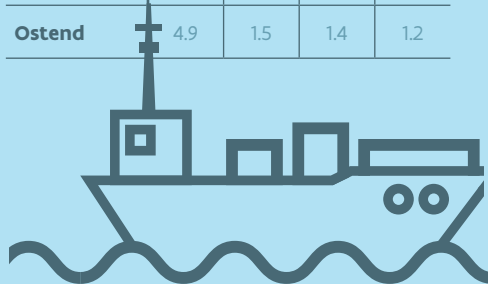

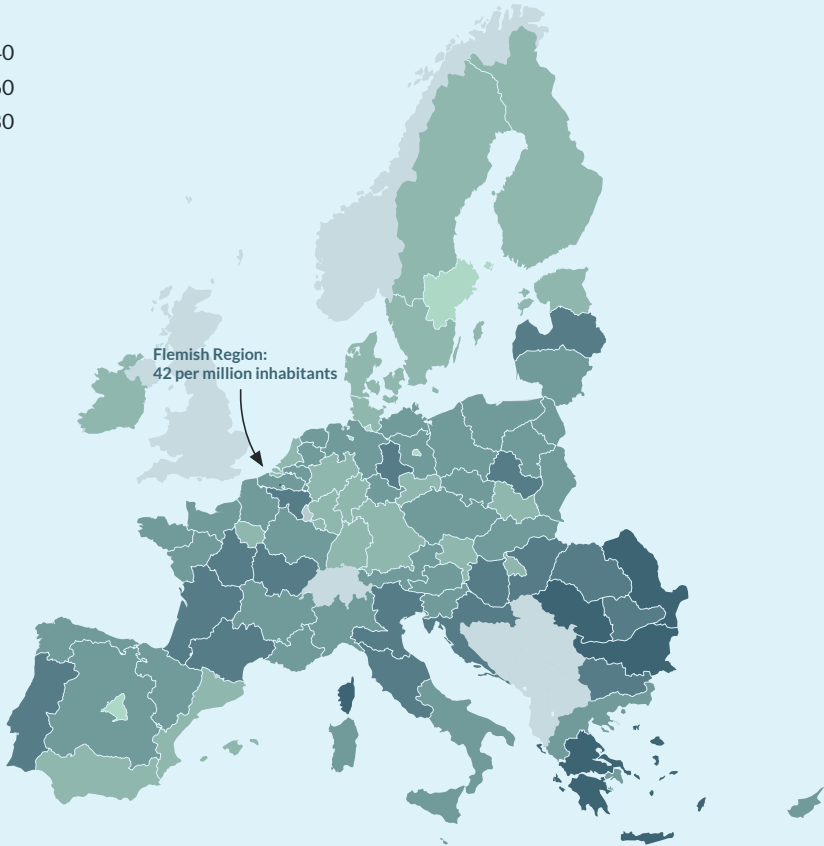

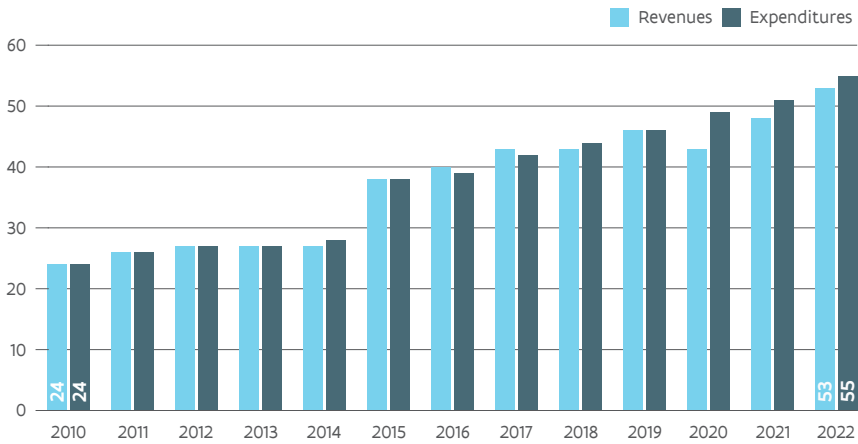

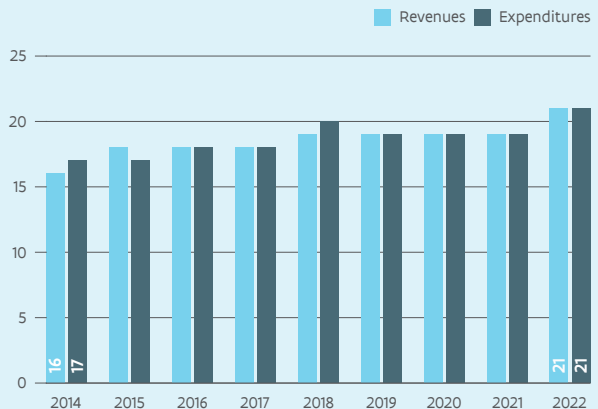
## Revenues and expenditures of the Flemish government

(billion euro, current prices)



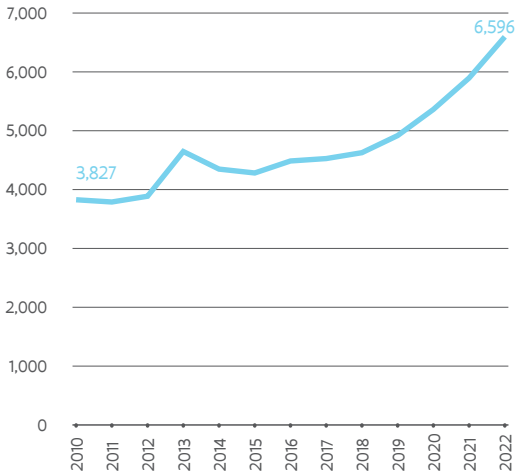
## Total revenues and expenditures of local governments

(billion euro)



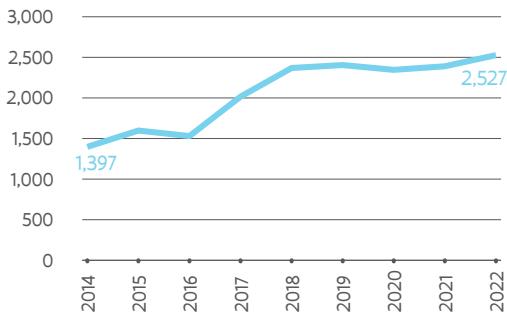
## Investment efforts of the Flemish government

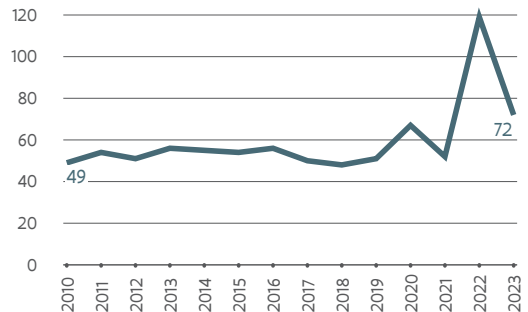
**Flemish government personnel** (number)

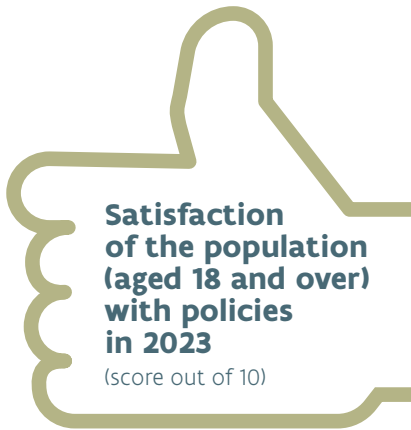
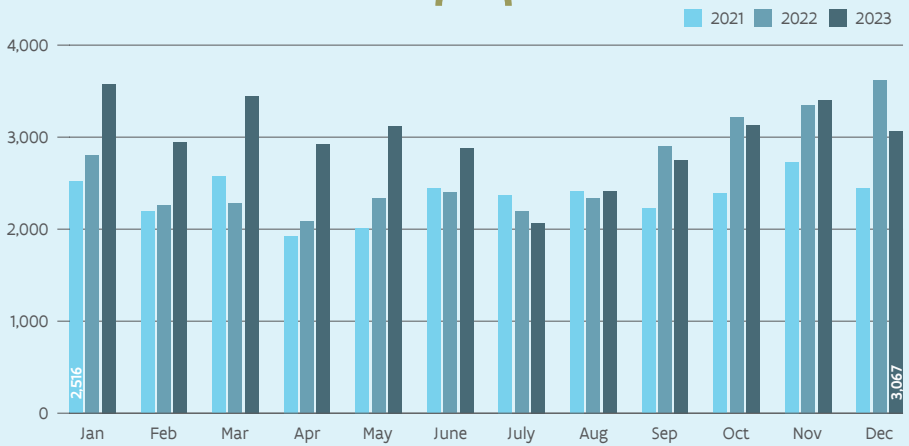

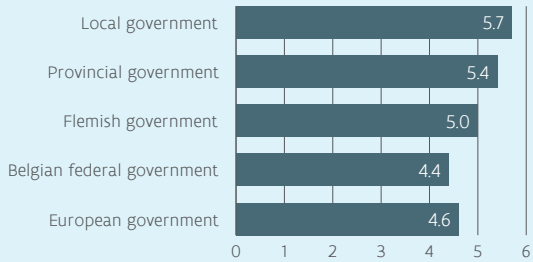
